

# Electronic Catch Reporting with eCatch



## Updating the eCatch App

### Automatic Updates

Both Android and iOS (Apple) devices have settings that allow automatic updating of Apps but often they're set to only update over wifi. The simplest way to update is to bring your device home with you one evening and connect it to the home wifi network. It should update overnight.

You can check the settings as follows:

#### iOS Devices

1. Open the Settings App 
2. Open the iTunes & App Store section 
3. Under Automatic Downloads make sure App Updates is switched on 
4. Under Mobile Data decide if you wish Automatic Downloads to be on or off. On will allow eCatch to update over cellular data.

#### Android Devices

1. Open the Play Store App 
2. In the Search bar at the top, tap on the three horizontal lines 
3. Tap on Settings 
4. Tap on Auto-update apps
5. Select Over any network
6. Tap on App download preference
7. Select either Over any network or Over Wi-Fi only, as you'd prefer. Over any network will allow eCatch to update over cellular data.

### Manual Updates

Both App stores will have a list of apps waiting to be updated. Finding this list will depend on the device and the version of the operating system. The easiest way to find an update is to search the store for the App itself:

#### iOS Devices

1. Open the App Store App 
2. Search for the eCatch Logbook app and tap on it 
3. Tap on the Update button 

#### Android Devices

1. Open the Play Store App 
2. Search for the eCatch Logbook app and tap on it 
3. Tap on the Update button
