How to Guide for Electronic Catch Reporting with eCatch



Recreational Catch Reporting

Under section 111 of the Fisheries Act fish caught using recreational methods during a commercial fishing trip have to be declared in a landing separate to the commercial catch. In eCatch you achieve this by doing another landing in the App using Landing Code F.

Note that you <u>should not</u> include your recreational catch in your commercial catch effort (Fishing Events). In addition, in eCatch version 5.26 and later anything landed using code F will not affect the totals of products caught commercially. However we still recommend that you do your recreational landing after your commercial landing.

Recreational Landing

- 1. Back on the <u>Trip Details</u> screen, tap on the <u>Add Landing</u> button.
- 2. Pick the <u>F Landing Code</u> (Section 111 recreational catch).
- 3. Leave <u>Is Offal Mealed</u> as No and <u>Oil Litres</u> blank.
- 4. Tap the <u>Add Product</u> button ______. Details of your commercial catch that hasn't been landed yet will be shown.
- 5. Tap on the Add Unlisted Species button.
- 6. Pick the Species from the list.
- 7. For the <u>Landing Item</u> just created, enter the following additional items:
 - o <u>Product State</u>: tap to select
 - Stock Code: if not already complete
 - o Green Weight (kg): enter your estimate of the total weight caught recreationally for this species.
 - <u>Container Type</u>: this should be set to <u>FIS</u> (Individual Fish)
 - o Estimated Container Weight (kg): enter your estimate of the weight of one fish
 - <u>Container Count</u>: auto populates. Check that it shows the correct number of fish. You can change it manually if required.
- 8. Add any other catch using the <u>Add Product</u> button then <u>Add Unlisted Species</u> button.
- 9. Check your entries for accuracy.
- 10. Tap the <u>Submit</u> button.
- 11. Enter your <u>PIN</u> if you have one, otherwise click <u>Ok</u> on the declaration.
